You have received this because you live in the Parish of Easebourne, which broadly comprises Easebourne Village, Henley and King Edward's.

Easebourne is preparing a 'Parish Design Statement' (PDS), to identify and record the characteristics of all the things that the parishioners love most and hold most precious about the parish. This document will then be used to influence future planning decisions.



Our PDS will set out what the people of Easebourne value in relation to design of new development or alterations to existing development. This could include, but isn't limited to, building materials, building size, building heights, building position on plot, relationship of building to the road.

In addition, we will also be using the consultation to better understand what the community value about the local landscape in Easebourne, this could include which views people value and which open spaces are important and warrant protection. Whilst our PDS will have limited influence in this matter, we will use this information to inform future discussions with the local planning authority about protecting important green spaces
