A power point presentation was shown, and Parish Councillors met informally with residents and discussed a variety of matters which are listed below (contact details of residents remain confidential):

- Traffic calming measures required for Wheelbarrow Castle to reduce speeding. Request that we inform Tom Richardson.
- Egmont Metis site - many concerns concerning inadequate parking provision for the flats residents and for visitors will lead to feral parking.
- Concern about entrance/exit proposals to the Conifers School Car Park as impractical - 11/12 Egmont Road residents.
- Great concern about traffic congestion caused by the construction traffic at Cowdray Yard and Egmont Sites.
- Request from Neil Sore for a simple guide to the planning processes.
- Picnic-in-the-Park date to be disseminated widely and speedily – Saturday, 3rd September 2022.
- Bridge between Midhurst and Easebourne should have a dedicated cycle lane.
- KEVII- concern that developers are using areas of the site as landfill with construction rubble. Issue for CDC enforcement.

- Egmont road one-way system being ignored by some - danger to all but especially Conifers Children.
- Several residents who had submitted an objection to the first Egmont Road planning application, did not receive notices about revised application; however, some did.
- Planning Notices concerning revised Egmont Road application were not posted (SDNPA are aware).
- Bollard on A272 near Wheelbarrow Castle damaged and requires repair.
